- Communicate with physicians, implement physician orders, and document and report pertinent information in patients' electronic medical records;
- Collect, store, and assure transport of certain specimens for laboratory studies;
- Ensure requisite health care service delivery supplies are managed;
- Communicate effectively with the EHCC team to assist in process design and troubleshooting when optimizing systems;
- Assist in the further development and implementation of best in class systems and processes, to support the acquisition and retention of patients; and
- Build and maintain long term relationships with patients by:
 - Communicating any issues regarding the client experience to facilitate continuous improvement.
 - Performing professionally at all times.
